

RESOLUTION 2009-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BAREFOOT BAY RECREATION DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO SEND LETTERS TO FLORIDA REPRESENTATIVE RALPH POPPELL AND FLORIDA SENATOR MIKE HARIDOPOLOS INFORMING THEM THAT THE BAREFOOT BAY RECREATION DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION INSTRUCTING THEM TO INTRODUCE AND SUPPORT LEGISLATION REPEALING SECTION 627.351 (6) (C) 16 OF FLORIDA STATUTES;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Barefoot Bay Recreation District (the "District") has, authorized the Chairman to send letters to Florida Representative Ralph Poppell and Florida Senator Mike Haridopolos informing them that the Barefoot Bay Recreation District Board of Trustees has passed a resolution instructing them to introduce and support legislation repealing section 627.351 (6) (c) 16 of Florida statutes.; and

WHEREAS, Beginning January 1, 2010, all renewal offers of policies that provide dwelling coverage on mobile or manufactured homes built prior to 1994 will include an actual cash value loss settlement; and

WHEREAS, Citizens Insurance is the provider of last resort and no other insurance companies will sell insurance to homeowners in the Barefoot Bay Recreation District; and

WHEREAS, Over 250 Barefoot Bay homeowners attended an October 13, 2009 meeting of the Barefoot Bay Homeowners Association to find out more about their Citizens Property Insurance; and

WHEREAS, When polled, all 250 homeowners agreed that Section 627.351 (6) (c) 16 of Florida Statutes that states as follows "*Must limit coverage on mobile homes or manufactured homes built prior to 1994 to actual cash value of the dwelling rather than replacement costs of the dwelling.*" was flawed and should be fixed; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BAREFOOT BAY RECREATION DISTRICT, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The chairman is authorized to send letters to Florida Representative Ralph Poppell and Florida Senator Mike Haridopolos informing them that the Barefoot Bay Recreation District Board of Trustees has passed a resolution instructing them to introduce and support legislation repealing section 627.351 (6) (c) 16 of Florida statutes.

Section 2. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective November 13, 2009.


