The Position: Pool Technician

Part-time position- approximately 20 hours per week

Pay Rate - \$13.70 per hour.

General Purpose:

Cleans, adjusts, and performs minor repairs to swimming pools and auxiliary equipment.

Essential duties include but are not limited to:

- Clean pool tiles, vacuum pool, hose down deck and surrounding area daily
 - Clean bathrooms, disinfect toilets and showers, replenish paper supplies.
 - Perform chemical tests on pool water; correct chemical levels as needed according to State of Florida regulations.
 - Observe any irregularities in the pit, heater room, or around the pool area. Report to the Crew Leader.
 - Maintain and repair pool heaters, feeder pumps and pumps.
 - Other duties as assigned.

Experience/Qualifications:

- Must have current CPO (Certified Pool/Spa Operator) certificate or successfully complete training course within one year of hire date.
 - Must be able to work with and around chemicals required for pool water disinfection (i.e., chlorine, stabilizers, diatomaceous earth, and any others currently in use or that may be required in the future).
 - Must be able to lift and move 50 pounds.
 - Ability to operate pool maintenance equipment.
