### Kid's Swim Program to Start Wednesday, June 9th, Pool #2, 4-6pm

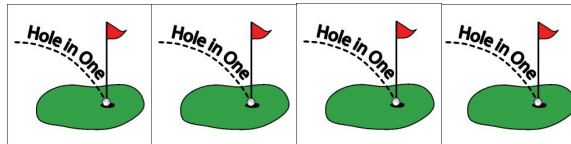
Effective June 9th the last two hours of every Wednesday at Pool #2 will be BBRD's official Kids' Swim. Homeowner/renters badges or guest passes are required. For those kids under 16 years old who do not have a homeowner or renters badge, their parent or guardian can bring the child and proof of residency in BBRD (driver's license, utility bill, etc.) and obtain a "Kids' Swim" badge that will allow the child access to Pool #2 during the Kids' Swim weekly event. The Kids' Swim badge will not allow access to the pools or other amenities outside of the Kids' Swim events. All regular Pool Rules will apply (see the BBRD Policy Manual or ask a Pool Host for details).
