### Project ideas now being accepted for Fiscal Years 23 through 27

As part of the FY23 Budget preparation process, staff is accepting ideas for new R&M/Capital ideas through December 3, 2021. Submittal of projects ideas by the deadline will enable staff to develop cost estimates for inclusion on the proposed FY23-27 5yrFM&CIP which will be provided to the BOT on March 7, 2022. ### Ad Hoc DOR Review Committee Vacancies

On October 26<sup>th</sup>, the BOT voted to begin solicitation of resumes/letters of interest from the public to serve on an ad hoc committee to review the BBRD Deed of Restrictions and proffer recommended changes to the BOT for their consideration of inclusion in a mailout election to all property owners. There will be five voting members and two alternates. Appointments to the committee will be on the December 3rd BOT Meeting agenda if a sufficient number of resumes/letters of interest are received. So far one resume has been received.
