The carcass shall be surrendered to a Brevard County Sheriff's Office Animal Services Officer or a veterinarian who shall prepare and ship the specimen to a laboratory for rabies examination.
- If the guarantined animal bites any person or other animal, said bite shall be reported by the owner to the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Animal Services.
- The owner agrees to permit observation and examination of the animal at any time by representatives of the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Animal Services or to take the animal to the veterinarian if directed by the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Animal Services.

- 12. The owner understands and agrees to submit the above-described animal for veterinary examination between the dates listed below. The owner agrees to immediately send the completed request form to be received by the second (2nd) working day from the date of veterinary examination.
- 13. A decision by the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Animal Services regarding approval, rejection or revocation of Home Quarantine is final. Failure to comply with any of these provisions will result in the issuance of a civil citation and civil penalty.






