1. No. 10 green is going to be rebuilt to USGA specs and therefore we have made a temporary green at the end of the 10th fairway. Please do not walk into the construction zone and adhere to all posted warning signs.
2. Our putting green will close to begin ABM's repair. Please remain away from the construction zone until it is re-opened.
