Many residents have asked the rules and statues regarding where to drive your golf cart. Below is a short explanation, the rest can be found by going to Online Statutes under Chapter 316.212.

A golf cart may be operated only upon a county road that has been designated by a county, a municipal street that has been designated by a municipality, or a two-lane county road located within the jurisdiction of a municipality designated by that municipality, for use by golf carts.

Peanut Butter Kiss Cookies

- 1 cup peanut butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 large egg, room temp.
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 30 milk chocolate kisses
- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Cream peanut butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla.
- 2. Roll into 1-1/4-in. balls. Place 2 in. apart on ungreased <u>baking sheets</u>. Bake until tops are slightly cracked, 10-12 minutes. Immediately press 1 chocolate kiss into center of each cookie. Cool for 5 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks
