Message from the Community Manager

- **BBRD DOR Amendment Ballot**

As a reminder, DOR ballots are due by October 4th at 4:30 pm to the BBRD Administration building via mail or drop off. The back of the return envelope needs to be signed in order for the ballot to be valid.

- **New Umbrellas**

Pools 2 & 3 will each soon be receiving two new umbrellas and bolt down bases that will allow them to withstand higher wind speeds of ~ 25 mph and therefore remain open longer to provide shade, rather than the current practice of being lowered or not used when winds reach a maximum speed of 10 mph.

- **Lounge Outside Bar Renovation**

At the August 23rd BOT meeting the board approved the contractors' proposals for the Lounge Outside Bar project at Pool #1. Once the contracts have been developed and signed, then the design plans will be created for permit submittal.

- **Weather Panels for the Pool #1 Stage**

At the August 23rd BOT meeting the board discussed the option of adding weather panels to the stage to add a layer of protection from weather. This will be on the September 8th board meeting agenda for their approval.

- **#10 Green Rebuild to USGA Specifications**

This FRDAP grant project for the BBRD Golf Course is nearing completion and the green is on course to open in October.

- **Pickle Ball and Tennis Resurfacing**

Due to weather issues, the vendor has rescheduled the commencement of this project to the week of September 5, 2022. The project will take approximately four weeks.

- **19th Hole Kitchen and Walk in Cooler Project**

Forty percent of this project is underway. The 19th Hole is closed for kitchen renovation and maintenance until further notice. The bar is now open Monday-Saturday 11a.m.-8 p.m. and Sundays 8a.m.-8p.m. Although the kitchen will be closed during construction, boxed lunches will be available.
