## Although things change, BBRD will remain the same

On Wednesday, April 27th, Community Manager Coffey submitted his resignation as BBRD Community Manager to SDS (company that employs BBRD's community manager since 2008) and notified the Trustees and staff. Mr. Coffey will become the Indian Harbour Beach City Manager effective May 16, 2022. His BBRD tenure of 8.5 years is the longest of the 9 community managers BBRD has employed since taking over operations from the developer in 1997 (average tenure prior to Mr. Coffey's arrival was 26 months with the longest being 31 months). Mr. Coffey's last day will be May 12th. SDS is currently recruiting for the next community manager. After May 12th (and until the next community manager starts work), representatives of SDS will come up to BBRD to keep things moving forward. While District Clerk Stephanie Brown will serve as SDS's day-to-day point of contact if residents have any immediate needs.
