The Results Are In



On Wednesday, October 5, 2022, the Barefoot Bay Recreation District Amended and Restated Deed of Restrictions (DOR) ballots were tabulated and the uncertified results showed that all 16 ballot questions were supported with a "Yes" vote in an overwhelming fashion. The BBRD lot owners' support of the 16 questions ranged from 85.1% to 92.8%. Ballot Question No. 11 garnered the greatest amount of Yes votes with 999. This amendment clarifies that occupants of a lot, not owners, are responsible for preventing nuisances on the lot. The October 25, 2022, BBRD Board of Trustees Regular meeting agenda will include an agenda item for the Trustees to certify the results. A well deserved thank you is in order for the BBRD lot owners and their participation in voting, the members of the Ad Hoc Deed of Restrictions Review Committee, and the BBRD staff that performed a very efficient and tedious counting of the 1,077 valid ballots. These ballots represent 22% of all the ballots that were mailed to the lot owners.

For residents that are registered to vote in BBRD, please remember to vote during the upcoming General Election, as BBRD has two referenda on the ballot. **No. 1 BBRD Charter Amendment Article IV Section 13:** *Shall the Barefoot Bay Recreation District Charter be amended to increase the Board of Trustees' common, real, or tangible personal property acquisition spending limit from \$25,000.00 to \$50,000.00?* **No. 2 BBRD Charter Amendment Article V Term Limits:** *Shall the Barefoot Bay Recreation District Charter be amended to limit the number of terms of members of the Board of Trustees of the District to no more than two (2) successive complete three (3) year terms and to provide standards for staggering the election cycles for Trustees?*
