Alexander Cartwright (inventor of modern Baseball) is inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame.

Wed., 14,1814

Francis Scott Key pens the poem "Defence of Fort M'Henry", later known as "The Star-Spangled Banner" while witnessing the bombardment of Fort McHenry from a ship in Baltimore harbor.

Thurs., 15,1916

First use of tanks in warfare, "Little Willies" at Battle of Flers-Courcelette, part of the Battle of the Somme.

Fri., 16,1940

FDR signs Selective Training & Service Act (1st peacetime draft).
